Programme Details

The Farmers Gateway Programme is made up of 23 credits identified by industry as essential for the retail workplace. The programme involves pre-workplace support plus:

- ▶ 10 days' work experience over a two week holiday programme.
- or one day a week for 10 weeks with Farmers

It costs \$500 +GST per student and results in a certificate. The certificate is made up of a set menu of credits (see below) which can be used towards a New Zealand Certificate in Retail.

As part of the Farmers Gateway package each student will receive:

- learning resources and assessment materials
- coaching support and assessment through a dedicated Schools Transitions Advisor.

Students will need to supply their own black polo shirt, black pants and black shoes to wear on training days.
