Students will be supplied with customised learning resources, clear development plans and support from the Schools Transitions Advisor who will keep their school up to date. Students' work will be assessed by ServiceIQ.

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Programme details

The programme involves work experience and runs nationwide.

It costs \$500 +GST per student and results in a Red Shirts in Schools certificate. The certificate is made up of a set menu of credits (see below) which can be used towards a New Zealand Certificate in Retail.

As part of The Warehouse Red Shirts in Schools package each student will receive:

- ▶ a work placement with The Warehouse
- ▶ customised learning resources
- ▶ assessment and support through a dedicated Schools Transitions Advisor
- ▶ Polo shirts (these will need to be returned on the last day).
